## **Ring 1 - Inhand - Commences 9am**

1. Youngster - 4 years and under
2. Veteran - horse/pony 16 years or above
3. Condition - horse/pony
4. Novice - combination never to have won a 1st place in any in-hand showing class  
To be judged on overall impression of both horse/pony and handler. Young and green horses/ponies shall be welcomed. Judge shall offer constructive feedback to all competitors. Please enter this class in the spirit in which it is intended.
5. Coloured - open to true and unusual coloureds (class may be split if sufficient entries)
6. Bays, Greys, Chestnuts, Blacks - horses/ponies (class may be split if sufficient entries)
7. Mountain and Moorland - open to pure and part bred
8. Horse/Pony according to type (excluding M&M's) (class may be split if sufficient entries)

**\*In-hand championship\*** for all horses/ponies placed 1st & 2nd in classes 1-8





## **Ring 2 : class 9. Christmas Handy Pony/Horse - 9.30am - 11.30am**

Competitors shall negotiate a course of Christmas obstacles. Each successfully negotiated obstacle shall enable points to be gained. Each round shall also be timed in the event two competitors finish the course with the same amount of points. Competitors shall be allowed to skip any obstacle they do not wish to attempt and move on to the next obstacle. They shall not be awarded the points available for that obstacle. The competitors with the most points, in the fastest times shall be placed.

Open to horses and ponies. Class shall be split as follows:

- a) Inhand & lead rein/assisted combinations
- b) Ridden unassisted combinations.

Sections placed separately. Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>. Trophies to the winners of each class.

## **Ring 1 - Novelty classes - To commence no earlier than 11.30am**

All classes are open to horses and ponies and can be entered ridden or in-hand.

10. Fancy dress - Open to horses and ponies.

11. Bonny pony/Handsome horse  
(class may be split if sufficient entries)

12. Hairiest horse/pony





## **Ring 1 - Ridden - To commence no earlier than 1.00pm**

13. Novice – combination never to have won a 1st place in any ridden showing class

To be judged on the overall impression of both horse/pony and handler. Young and green horses/ponies shall be welcomed. Judge shall offer constructive feedback to all competitors. Please enter this class in the spirit in which it is intended.

*(no group canter in this class - competitors may show or attempt a canter in their individual show but no additional marks shall be awarded)*

14. Veteran - horse/pony 16 years or above

15. Coloured - open to true and unusual coloureds (class may be split if sufficient entries)

16. Bays, Greys, Chestnuts, Blacks - horse/pony (class may be split if sufficient entries)

17. Mountain & Moorland - open to pure and part-bred

18. Cob - including maxi cobs, natural state or hogged (class may be split if sufficient entries)

19. Hunter Horse/Pony (class may be split if sufficient entries)

20. Hack/Riding Horse/Show Pony (class may be split if sufficient entries)

**\*Ridden championship\*** - for all horses/ponies placed 1st & 2nd in classes 9-17





## **Show Rules**

1. Hats to the current BHS standard with harness secured at three points at least must be worn at ALL times when mounted. Competitors should note the change in BHS hat standards introduced in 2016. Only the following now meet the standard:
  - PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) and must be BSI Kitemarked
  - VG1 01.040 (2014-12) and must be BSI Kitemarked
  - ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) and must be SEI marked
  - SNELL E2001 and must have official SNELL label and number
  - AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) and must have SAI Global mark
  - EN1384 or BSEN1384 is only acceptable if one of the above standards is also displayed. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their hat complies with these new standards.
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. Everyone on the showground must obey instructions from the organisers.
3. Entries are made at your own risk. NO liability can be accepted for accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders or any other person or property however caused. Competitors must have third party insurance and are advised to have their horse's passports with them.
4. The organisers have the right to alter, merge or cancel classes at their discretion.
5. The judge's decision is final.
6. All complaints must be directed to the show co-ordinator.
7. Abusive behavior towards judges or stewards will not be tolerated and will result in the competitor being asked to leave.
8. Entry fees cannot be refunded, except if the show or a class has to be cancelled.
9. Making an entry constitutes acceptance of the rules. No entry without payment of entry fee.
10. Dogs must be kept on a lead at ALL times. NO dogs allowed in the cafe area but are permitted in the viewing gallery, provided they do not cause nuisance to the competitors.
11. Please keep the showground tidy and take your litter home with you.
12. NO STALLIONS over 2 years old.
13. Any horse behaving in an unsafe manner will be asked to leave the arena.
14. Competitors under 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
15. Membership will be accepted on the day and will qualify for reduced entry fee
